

Watercolor paper, empty (high) can or glass, Scalloped tag punch
Pads/re inkers: Poolparty, Coastal Cabana, Bermuda Bay, Island
Indigo; Cardstock: Island indigo, Neutral white; Ribbon: Island
Indigo, Linen Thread; Perfect pearls; Cristal effects; glue

step 1

Make a tag 2" wide with the tag punch

step 2

fill the can or glass with water so you can fully dip the tag and
add drops of the lightest color reinker (Pool Party).

step 3

Put the tag fully in the colored water and let it soak for a couple
of minutes till the paper colors. I found the color was not strong
enough (even after applying more drops of ink, so I used my inkpad
to dap on the soaked paper and dipped it shortly again in the water)

step 4

Repeat with the other three colors from light though darker (Coastal
Cobana, Bermuda Bay, Island Indigo) and dip less of the tag in the water
with each color.

step 5

Dry fully. Add a small tag, an embossed flower and some ribbon. Done!

To get harsh line between the color, just dip the paper and hold still. Drying between the colors might help as well.
To get soft lines, move the tag while dipping and do not let the paper dry to much between the colors. You can move
the colors around a bit till it's completely to your liking.

The same "Ombre technique" effect you can achieve with the Cardstock colors and your fringe scissors or rose-die.
